I. Summary

- The Lock and Key Intervention Primary Screening (IPS) Program identifies, diffuses and clears major issues that cause problem behavior
- The program uses a controlled communication process that is non-threatening and non-invasive,
- The program is based on a process that connects the episodic memory with the DNA or invisible cell that is embedded within its own incident from the past. Once the issue is identified, diffused and cleared, the client has no further urge or need for committing the problem behavior. Example drugs, alcohol, violence, crime reoffending etc.
- The purpose of this proposal is to provide a holistic (social and emotional well-being) effective and efficient program to address behavioral problems Aboriginals and other representatives of the Community; Example abuse obesity depression hopelessness anxiety.
- The benefits include improved behavior, improved intervention results, community well-being and enhanced public image of Aboriginals and Communities
- Costs are on a per client basis, with a guarantee that no payment is due if no result is achieved
- The proposal includes introduction and trial session, with representatives present to observe and evaluate the program's effectiveness
- Evidence – based preventive health strategies in Aboriginals theatre, has many shortcomings and with introduction of this proposal will assist to establish well-being in communities.

II. Introduction

The Lock and Key Intervention Primary Screening Program utilizes the theory of para-psychological study of DNA episodal memory code. This theory provides the ability to access the cellular points, or invisible cells of the body where the cause or triggers of the problem behavior/s are hidden, and the effect or incident of one's created imbalance.

The cause is assessed back along created dimensions of time to find the age when the incident was created.

The incident is then located along the timeline, to identify when the DNA and episodal memory was disconnected. There the invisible cell was set up, usually by emotional critical incident trauma.

When the cell is located and the cause and effect identified, the DNA episodal memory code can be reconnected and the cause of the incident can be diffused and cleared.

In simple terms, when we change the past, we change the present.

The program brings the client from a position of imbalance to a position of balance, by breaking the episodal memory cycle.

The program has the ability to identify and assist the client to find the original incident and cause of the created effect at a created age. When diffused and cleared at its creation, it no longer has an effect in the present day. Aboriginal Modality.

III. Needs/Problems

The current behavioral problems experienced by Aboriginals, particularly where grog and drugs are used, have been thoroughly described in the various media over the past few years. The problems include:

- Violence/murder
- Anger
- Family Breakdown/abuse
- Suicide and Attempted Suicide
- Fear
- Hysteria
- Rape
- Schizophrenia
- Self Harm
- Re-offences Crime/ Corrective Services

- Disreputable Action
- Demons Within
- Drug and Alcohol Dependence
- Self Medication
- Depression
- Bipolar Condition
- Anxiety
- Gambling
- Abuse Victims
- Children Status – Petrol chomring

There is no disputing that change is required to address these problems and many other major issues affecting Aboriginal people.

Bodies that do not acknowledge Universal Law, namely those who do not provide duty of care where requested in areas of need causing hardship, unrest, violence, anger and emotional trauma, are open to malignant imbalance themselves.

Once you know the issues from your position of power and others suffer by your action or inaction, then you violate law.

No individual, institution, corporation or power-seeking group can escape the cycle of time. Therefore, what you create must enfold back on to its creator.

IV. Goals/Objectives

The primary goal of this proposal is to achieve implementation of the Sims Computer Lock and Key Intervention Primary Screening Program (IPS), in order to assist -:

Prevent suicide, suicide attempts and selfharm

- Clear emotional trauma
- Treat depression and other major mental health issues
- Achieve discipline rehabilitation/ Grog and Alcohol
- Prevent abuse
- Manage and stop violence and anger in communities
- Diffuse and clear the need for petrol chomring, grog and drugs to name a few.

Benefits to the Individual Aboriginals include:

- Access to an efficient and effective system of dealing with the above problems
 - Improved relationships overall
 - Provide an alternative and choice for Individuals in need.
 - Increased opportunities for Individuals due to improved emotional well-being
 - No funding or jobs losses by communities or existing health services
- Introduction and Screening sessions can be translated to any culture and language required.**

V. Procedures/Scope of Sessions

The sessions entail three parts, involving the following processes:

Part 1

- Introduction

Part 2

- Consent
- Control
- Communication
- Connection
- Location

Part 3

- Diffuse and Clear

The emphasis is on finding the cause and effect of the incident that is triggering the identified behavior, and diffusing and clearing the issue, resulting in prevention of the behavior.

The entire process is achievable in a relative short session, which is drug free.

All major issues may not be diffused and cleared in one session, as both surface and hidden issues may exist. New Computer Lock and Key Intervention Primary Screening assures efficacy.

The first session aims to identify the cause effect/incident, Major Issue imbalance and subsequent sessions are targeted to other issues in order of priority.

The intent of the program is not to convince or force a response, only to assist with locating issues, diffusing and clearing them.

It is imperative that the client is willing to participate and give his/her consent to the process, as the process cannot be effective without voluntary client consent. The client must be true in their intent and must be willing to benefit from the program.

VI. Empirical Testing

Results of sessions will be summarized in true and reliable form, maintaining confidentiality of clients and families and using ethical protocols and reporting guidelines.

Reporting will be transparent, confidential, and in adherence to privacy laws.

No evidence – base Empirical testing available no other program available to compare results. IPS program covers a wide range of problems and boasts a 99% success rate when location is established of episodal memory code DNA.

Time does not permit further research and testing –
Aboriginals at point of EXTINCTION

VII. Costs
